

**PLANNING BOARD PUBLIC HEARING- November 20, 2008 at 6:30 PM**

Proposed Land Use Ordinance Change

Automobile graveyard/junkyard: A yard, field, or other area used as a place of storage, other than temporary storage by an establishment or place of business which is engaged primarily in doing auto body repair work for the purpose of making repairs to render a motor vehicle serviceable, ~~for three (3) or more unserviceable, discarded, worn out, or junked motor vehicles as defined in 29 M.R.S.A. Sec. 1(7), or parts thereof.~~ **which may include an area used for automobile dismantling, salvage and recycling operations OR other outside area used to store, dismantle or otherwise handle:**

- A. Three (3) or more unregistered or un-inspected motor vehicles, as defined in Title 29-A, section 101, subsection 42, or parts of the vehicles;**
- B. Discarded, worn-out or junked plumbing, heating supplies, electronic or industrial equipment, household appliances or furniture;**
- C. Discarded, scrap and junked lumber; and**
- D. Old or scrap copper, brass, rope, rags, batteries, paper trash, rubber debris, waste and all scrap iron, steel and other scrap ferrous or nonferrous material.**
